Also, the financial powers delegated to the Director may not be further delegated to other authorities; and

BOG/41/2020-06/05: While processing a case for promotion, only the eligible persons in the feeder grade are to be considered while duly following the RRs and the procedure prescribed in the DoPT OM No. 35034/7/97-Estt(D) dated 08/02/2002 as amended from time to time. The said provisions

have not been followed while processing the cases of promotion.

However matter related to point No.(ii), the matter is being relooked/examined in terms of the rules and action taken report shall be submitted in the next BoG meeting.

It is submitted that the proposal to change the functionaries in the Institute was submitted to the Hon'ble Chairman through office UO note dated 16/07/2020 and the approval to this effect was accorded by the Hon'ble Chairman, therefore matter is submitted for ratification please.

Decision: The Board unanimously ratified the above approval.

VI. To ratify the approval accorded for giving consent to research projects involving nil Over Head charges funded by HIMCOSTE Shimla.

It is submitted that 03 Nos of research projects involving zero overhead charges was sanctioned by HIMCOSTE, Shimla to our faculty members.
