### NIT Hamirpur Delegation Visited UTS, Sydney

In order to conduct high quality research it is essential to know how other leading institutions are working and what facilities are available with those institutions. Under the able guidance of its Chairman, Board of Governor it was decided to explore the possibility of working closely with some of the reputed universities within India and abroad and tie up with them for various academic activities to pursue the goals as laid down by the Institute. The institute in its effort contacted several universities and could find one partner namely University of Technology Sydney which showed interest in a tie up with NIT Hamirpur and help in delivery of quality education. A delegation of faculty members from University of Technology, Sydney Australia (UTS) visited India and about fifteen faculty members of NIT Hamirpur participated in the discussions held with them at Shimla in March 2006. On pursuing the issue and establishing confidence in each other another delegation from UTS visited India and signed an MOU with NIT Hamirpur on November, 2006. The MOU broadly facilitates collaboration in various areas such as helping in creation of research facilities and in conduction of research. It also suggests that the collaborative research programmes, joint consultancy works, faculty and students exchange programme etc. could be taken. All this is expected to strengthen the collaboration between UTS and NIT Hamirpur and also adding more institutions form India and Australia to work jointly in the research areas which are of current interest. In this regard, UTS and NIT Hamirpur along with DCE and TERI have already submitted one proposal for the strategic research fund to Department of Science and Technology, Government of India for supporting these activities, which is under active consideration.

In order to achieve the objective as laid down in MOU signed between two institutions it was essential to understand each other systems and explore the specific areas where the work could be carried out jointly at both the institutions. An invitation was received from UTS that a team may visit UTS during 10-14<sup>th</sup> of April, 2007 and identify the areas in which the joint collaborative work could be carried out. A delegation of four member from NIT, Hamirpur including the Dr. R.L. Chauhan, Chairman BOG, Dr. I.K. Bhat, Director NIT, Dr. A.S. Singha, Dean (Academic) and Dr. Anoop Kumar, Coordinator Energy Centre visited UTS during proposed period. On reaching UTS the team held intensive discussions with various functionaries and Heads of Research Groups of UTS.

During the deliberations, Prof. Archie Johnston, Dean Faculty of Engineering while introducing the NIT Delegate members to UTS Faculty praised the good work done by NIT Hamirpur in the field of Technical Education rated NIT Hamirpur as one of the leading institutions among the NITs. The Indian Delegation held extensive deliberations and visited various facilities, labs, centres of excellence and looked at the facilities that could be used by the students and the faculty of NIT Hamirpur for pursuing their research and development activities. On the basis of these discussions the Indian Delegation made few presentations and these were on : Technical Education System in India and Introduction to NIT, Hamirpur and the possible areas in which the collaboration programme can be started immediately. The discussion held by the visiting delegation helped to understand the programme structure, the course contents, financial implications, academic requirements, the evaluation system of UTS etc. The visit helped in understanding the academic environment in which UTS works and also identify the research areas of strength wherein more faculty members could be sent for training purposes so as to give them an exposure and on their return can contribute in developing similar facilities at NIT Hamirpur.

Some of the areas where both the institutions can start the collaboration for training and research were, Robotics and Mechatronics, Autonomous Systems, Bio-medical and Bio-Technology, Energy management and policy, Material Science and Nanotechnology, Electronics and Tecommunication Technology, Microwave Propagation, Wireless Computing and Security.

UTS has agreed to provide training to the faculty members of NIT, Hamirpur in the areas of its strengths. It also agreed to organize jointly: short term training programmes and conferences, projects to be submitted to various funding bodies, to facilitate the research and development works in both the institutions.

### Campus Close-up

- A new office section building of our institute was inaugurated by Sh. Virbhadra Singh Jee, honorable chief minister of Himachal Pradesh, on 31<sup>st</sup> January 2007. He was accompanied by Dr. R.L. Chauhan, Chairman BOG of our institute, and other dignitaries on this occasion. The new office section space, which is equipped with all modern amenities, has been constructed to house various administrative sections of our institute.
