**Revised Guidelines for Conducting End Semester Examination
Bachelor and Master Programmes (except First Year), December 2020**

1. The End Semester Examination (Practical Examination, Evaluation of PG Project/Dissertation, Theory Examination, PhD Seminar, Evaluation of UG Project etc.) of JG/PG programmes (except first year) shall be held during 30.11.2020 to 23.12.2020 through Online Mode.

2. End Semester Practical Examination, **Evaluation of PG Project/Dissertation**, PhD Seminar and Evaluation of UG Project scheduled from 30.11.2020 to 04.12.2020, 07.12.2020 to 20.12.2020 (**preferably schedule this between 14.12.2020 to 20.12.2020**), 01.12.2020 to 20.12.2020 and 21.12.2020 to 23.12.2020 respectively shall be carried out through online mode at Department Level.

3. The centrally prepared **Date Sheet and Invigilation duties roaster** for conducting **End Semester Theory Examination** in Online Mode shall be further shared with Departments by 27.11.2020 for their comments.

The final version shall be shared with Departments on 01.12.2020. The same shall also be made available on Institute website for the information of students. The concerned Department shall also share it with the students through CRs.

4. The examination, its weightage and duration shall be as follows:

5. For conducting the examination smoothly, the class shall be divided into groups of 45 students at max, for which the Head of Departments shall ask their staff/faculty concerned to do the job. Each group of students shall have separate Google Meet Link, **which shall be common for appearing in all the examinations for the Group concerned**. Subject teacher along with other invigilators (one or two as the case may be for which the Academic Section will issue the invigilation duty roaster of faculty members) shall conduct the exam.
6. The concerned subject teacher along with other invigilators shall be responsible for conduct of examination through Google Classroom/Meet and for resolving query (if any). **The schedule notified centrally (Date Sheet) shall be strictly adhered.**
7. **The subject teacher-cum-invigilator as well as other invigilators shall join the Google Meet link at least 10 Minutes prior to the start of the exam**, give the necessary instructions to the students and share the question paper through Google Classroom/email at appropriate time so that it is available to the students well in time at the start of examination.
8. For effective invigilation the faculty is requested to use desktop/laptop. Kindly avoid performing invigilation duties on mobile phones.
9. Head of the Departments shall convey the generated Google Meet Links for each class to O/o Associate Dean (E&E) positively by 02.12.2020 so that the same may be informed formally to the students. Head of Departments shall also ensure that the student get the appropriate Google Meet Link through their subject teacher well in advance.



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10. In case of any specific requirement like graph paper, drawing sheet or any other reference material the concerned subject teacher shall inform the students well in advance.
11. Subject Teacher, Invigilators, Student and all other functionaries shall join the supplied Google Meet Link using their official Email Ids.
12. The subject teacher and invigilator shall announce the important instructions at the start of examination.
13. Students need to prepare well in time along with the items required (stationary, desktop/laptop, internet connectivity, data pack and any other specific requirement communicated by concerned faculty) to undertake the examination.
14. The students need to join Google Meet Link atleast 10 Minutes prior to the start of Exam and they need to keep the camera ON till the submission of their Answer Sheets. If any student fails to keep the camera in ON mode, he/she may be marked absent by the invigilator.
15. The concerned subject teacher alongwith other invigilators (if any) shall maintain the attendance and record the video of examination for the entire duration.
16. Each student is required to write his/her Name, Roll No, Subject Name, Subject Code, Programme, Semester, Department, Date of Exam and Number of Pages written on top of first sheet and put Signature with Date at the bottom of each sheet of the answer booklet.
17. If a student is found guilty of indulging unfair means, strict action as per Institute Rules shall be initiated against him/her.
18. After the examination time is over, the students shall be given extra 15 minutes to scan and upload their answer booklets on Google Classroom or send back on subject teacher's Email Id. Further, delay in submission by a student may lead to deduction in marks or rejection of whole answer booklet.
19. The students need to save the pdf of their answer sheets by the name "rollno subjectcode.pdf" e.g. xxxxxsd211.pdf and upload the same on the classroom.
20. The students shall retain the hardcopies of their answer sheets with them and handover the same to the teacher concerned while they come back in the Institute Campus.
